A 17-year-old girl, Taye Gasau has been murdered at Idosemo in Ipokia local government area of Ogun State. Gasau, who was

PENDENT gathered were arrested by men of the Ogun State Command of the Vigilance Group (VGN) after the incident was reported to them.

According to a statement by the Public Relations Officer of the Group, Gasau's head and arm were severed while her remains were dropped in a well at an underdeveloped parcel of land at Igude.

"The victim, Taye Gusau who was hawking puff-puff after returning from school in the evening of her adoption, was accosted by the two criminals, who lured her into the bush and murdered her".

"The parents of the victim reported the to the VGN when they could not trace her whereabouts four days ago.

"The prompt intervention of our men led to the arrest of Tailoju, who confessed that the innocent girl was killed for money ritual and named his partner in crime, as Soji Asamo, now in police net.

"He later took officers of the VGN to where her corpse was dumped after severing her head and hands, while her intestines were also removed".

The Commandant of

the VGN, Olanrewa Adedovin said the m ter will be handed ov to the Police for furth investigations and pr ecution.

The arrest, according to the police, followed complaint by the su pect's husband, Jame Micheal, who reporte to have pleaded on the suspect over the di agreement between th two chaps.

Before the arrival of the husband from wor the police said, the su pect had used raze blade to inflict deep cu on the girls hand an thigh.

Police said, "On in terrogation, the suspec owned up to the commi sion of the offence bu blame it on the devil a she clair.ed not to know what come over her tha made her did so.

'The victim has been taken to Lenard Hospita Ogijo where she is cur rently on admission."

Woman, 20, Dumps Day Old Baby In Toilet

Shamsiyya Hassan, a 20-year-old Woman who delivered a baby boy at Nasarawa community of Funtua Local Government Area and abandoned him in a pit toilet is currently in custody of the police in Katsina State.

Shamsiyya, who was arrested alongside one Jamilu, her boyfriend. for adultery and other criminal charges, said she got married a day after she gave birth and she was afraid of her husband, hence the action.

Her words: "I delivered the baby myself and decided to dump it inside the toilet pit, but while I was coming out of the toilet, a neighbour heard the cry of the baby and drew the attention of the people, who confronted me and I told them that I dumped the baby in the toilet pit'

INDEPENDENT gathered that the woman gave birth to four children for her first husband, who divorced her and she had a boyfriend, who impregnated her, but would not take responsibility responsibility for the pregnancy and she got married to one, who did not know she was pregnant.

Gambo Isah, police spokesman for Katsina State Police Command, confirmed the incident to newsmen on Sunday, saying that she delivered and dumped the baby in the toilet a day after she had got married to another man and she did that to make her return fresh in the eyes of the day old-husband.

According to Isa, a

Deputy Superintendent of Police,(DSP), the cry of the baby attracted the attention of neighbours to the toilet, where it was rescued alive and taken to Ahmadu Bello University Teaching hospital, Shika, Zaria, were the baby died after five days.

His words: "during the cause of investigation, the police discovered that the man she got married to did not know she was pregnant, but the police arrested somebody she said impregnated her and her boyfriend (Jamilu)".
