Lagos - Olori Opeyemi Omobolawa Fola, Deputy Director, O-Ambulance Services in Osun State, allegedly died through a phone-triggered gas explosion during the week in Osogbo.

Reports have it that Fola, a trained and certified nurse and president, Rotary Club International, Osogbo GRA chapter, on Wednesday, December 13, decided to drive to a gas station to re-fill her cylinder.

"But, along the line, her phone rang and when she picked the call, the phone exploded with fire, flung her cylinder to a distant place, and roasted her and the car and she reportedly died before she could get help," our source said.

It was further gathered that some other persons at the station received various degrees of injuries, due to the explosions.
