Four Dead, 13 Injured In Lagos/Ibadan Auto Crash

No fewer than four persons, Saturday night, lost their lives in an accident involving which occurred at the ever busy Lagos/

Ibadan expressway.

The Ogun Sector Commander, Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), Clement Oladele who confirmed the incident to newsmen in Abeokuta on Sunday said the crash involved white Innosson bus and a Toyota Sienna.

Oladele said the accident happened at around 8:pm opposite a private University at Km 82 along the Lagos/Ibadan Expressway.

The sector commander said that the accident was suspected to be caused by overspeeding on the part of the two vehicles which resulted into head-on collision.

He said "The two ve-

hicles involved in the crash are Innosson bus with registration number AKL 450 YY and Toyota Sienna with registration number FST 370 DC. A

"A total of 23 people comprising 18 Male Adult, four Female Adult and one female child, were involved in the crash.

"13 people made up of nine male, three female and one male child were injured in the accident while two male and two female died".

Oladele said that the compses of the victims had been taken to the Fakoya Mortuary, Sagamu, while the injured victims were taken to Broad Life Hospital at Olowotedo and Idera Hospital at Sagamu.

He urged motorists to drive cautiously and obey all traffic rules and regulations.

He explained that the Mowe Police Station had been informed of the incident.
