

# Security Operatives Kill Rivers Massacre Mastermind, Two Others

## ● Rivers Govt Commends Team As Nigerians Jubilate

Notorious cult leader, kidnap kingpin and mass murderer, Johnson Igwedibia, popularly known as Don Waney, has met his waterloo.

The 6 Division, Nigerian Army, Port Harcourt, announced this on Sunday.

Don Waney's group is believed to have shot dead Over 17 church worshippers in Omoku area of Rivers State on New Year day.

It would be recalled that in the early hours of Monday, November 20, 2017, troops of 6 Division Nigerian Army, acting on credible information from members of the public, raided the Don Waney enclave in Omoku, ONELGA, Rivers State, where shocking discoveries of assorted weapons, dynamite, bags of suspected cannabis, full military camouflage uniforms, military boots, military communication radios, 10 human skulls and human bones were discovered.

Also, in continuation of the operation on Tuesday, November 21, 2017,

the troops also exhumed decomposing bodies of some of his victims in his shrine.

Not satisfied with the numerous lives of innocent citizens he took, Don Waney allegedly masterminded the despicable New Year day mayhem in Omoku and was alleged to be planning yet another bloody attack in the area.

Intense surveillance activities on him and his gang by the Department of State Services (DSS), Rivers State Command, revealed that after committing these atrocities he relocated to a neighbourhood within Enugu town, Enugu State, where he rented an apartment and started living among unsuspecting neighbours within the community.

From the relative safety of his newly-rented apartment, Don Waney was already perfecting plans to accomplish another mayhem in Omoku in which he was to attack churches, schools, army and police locations and other residences in Omoku.

However, following his successful geo-location to his new Enugu

neighbourhood hideout by the DSS, Rivers State Command, a combined team of troops from 82 Division, Nigerian Army, Enugu, and personnel of DSS Rivers State Command, raided the hideout to arrest him and his other accomplices.

Incidentally, on sensing that the combined team was closing in on his residence, Don Waney; Ikechukwu Adiele, his second-in-command, and Lucky Ode, another gang member, attempted to escape through the back exit of the apartment but they were shot down by the troops in the process.

One of them died on the spot while the other two who sustained gunshot wounds eventually died while being evacuated for medical attention.

The remains of Don Waney and his cohorts were brought back to Port Harcourt, Rivers State, by the combined team and handed over to the Rivers State Police Command for further action.

The dead bodies of the three men were copiously displayed at the premises of the 6 Division, Port Harcourt.
