## Man Allegedly Conspires To Rob, Kill Friend In Bauchi

Suspected armed robbers arrested by the Police.

Bauchi - Sulieman Yunusa, a 40-year-old resident of Magama Gumau in Toro Local Government Area of Bauchi State, has been sent to his early grave by a close friend, who allegedly conspired with suspected robbers to rob and subsequently kill the friend.

Yunusa's friend, identified as Ahmadu Ngari betrayed him, when he conspired with robbers who carried out the robbery operation.

Kamal Datti Abubakar, police spokesman for Bauchi police command, in a statement made available to newsmen on Tuesday, said two suspects have been arrested in connection with the killing of Yunusa.

Kamal, a Deputy Superintendent of Police said, "Abubakar Sadiq Mohammed, 20, and Yahaya Mohammed, 18, of Ladduga village, Toro LGA, has been arrested in connection with the killing of one Suleiman Yunusa.

His words: "The suspects arrested when quizzed by police detectives confessed to have conspired among themselves and one Ahmadu Ngari, a commercial Motorcycle rider, now at large and committed the crime".

"Ngari is a close and trusted friend of the deceased, whom he usually calls, whenever he need his service, but was betrayed by inviting members of his robbery gang, who attacked, robbed and eventually killed him", he said.

"The robbery incident was reported at Toro Police Station, that on 28/12/2017, at about 2340hrs unknown gunmen stormed the resident of one Sulaiman Yunusa,40, 'm' of Magama Gumau village, Toro LGA ,Bauchi State, with an intent to rob in the process, stabbed and shot him, as a result he sustained serious injuries where he was rushed to General Hospital Toro and later referred to ATBU Teaching Hospital Bauchi but died on 30/12/2017 while receiving treatment.

"Discreet investigation by the Police attached to Toro Police Station led to the arrest of the two suspects and exhibits recovered from them include, two locally made revolver rifles, eight live ammunition of AK47 rifle, five empty shells of AK47 rifle recovered at the scene of crime and one red cap.
