Man Kills Octogenarian Father In Enugu

ENUGU The Enugu State Police Command has launched an investigation into the death of an octogenarian, Nathaniel Chukwuemerie, who was allegedly killed by his son at Ojinato community in Oji River LGA of the State.

The victim was 83 years old as at the time of his unfortunate death, which occurred last weekend.

It was gathered that on that fateful day, Chukwuemerie who hailed from Ogidi in Idemili North LGA of Anambra State, but resided at Ojinato met his death when his son identified as 'The Boy', allegedly smashed his father's head with a pestle.

Ebere Amaraizu, the spokesman of Enugu State Command who confirmed this report in a statement, said the reason the son took his father's life had not been ascertained.

According to Amaraizu, a Superintendent of Police, following the development, the victim was promptly rushed by sympathizers to a nearby hospital where he was confirmed dead.
