Troops Kill Four Boko Haram Terrorists

Maiduguri – Troop of 192 Battalion deployed in Operation Lafiya Dole have killed three Boko Haram terrorists in an ambush successfully staged against marauding Boko Haram terrorists along Lokodisa village in Gwoza Local Government Area of Borno State.

Acting on reliable intelligence reports, the valiant troop staged the ambush in the early hours of Thursday, 7 June 2018 neutralising the terrorists after a gun duel. The troop also recovered three dane guns, five bicycles and a trolley.

Disclosing this, Col. Onyema Nwachukwu said, in another encounter, troop of 145 Battalion deployed in eight task force division area of responsibility have killed a Boko Haram terrorist at Gashigar in Abadam Local Government Area of Borno State.

The terrorist, he revealed, was killed during a failed attempt by fleeing terrorists to escape through an identified route used by the insurgents. The vigilant troop also recovered one AK 47 rifle and one magazine loaded with 25 rounds of 7.62 mm ammunition from the insurgents.

"Meanwhile, 38 returnee refugees from Zigage in the Republic of Cameroon were today received by troops of three Battalions at Gamboru, in Ngala Local Government Area of Borno State. The refugees comprising 11 men, six women and 21 children have been profiled and handed over to officials of Gamboru Internally Displaced Persons camps," Col. Nwachukwu stated.
