Military On Red Alert In Adamawa As Boko Haram Attacks 13 Villages

Yola – The Boko Haram terror group has again attacked about 13 villages in Madagali and Michika local government areas of Adamawa State.

During the massive attack which occurred on Wednesday, a vigilante and some other persons were seriously wounded while one of the Boko Haram commanders was killed.

Due to sporadic bomb attacks in the state, it has been placed on red alert by the Nigerian military.

Some local government areas in the state like Madagali, Yola North, Mubi North, Michika, Gombi have been cordoned off by heavy military presence due to the red alert.

Military sources said the action was made necessary because of attempts by Boko Haram to increase attacks in the areas.

The security situation is particularly critical in Madagali town which has been completely cordoned off and security patrol intensified.

Sources said the military had alerted the people of the state to watch out for places such as Jimeta ultra-modern market believed to be one of the targets of Boko Haram.

Soldiers were seen on the streets of Yola, with some roads cordoned off while searches were done on motorists.
