Herdsmen Kill 48 In Adamawa Community, Burn Houses

Yola – Suspected Fulani herdsmen have raided some villages in Mayo-Belwa Local Government Area of Adamawa State killing about 48 persons.

Reports from Mayo-Belwa said the gunmen arrived in the villages of Mayo Lope, Yojjin, Bujun, Ugbakka, and Wakka shooting sporadically and burning houses while residents were asleep.

Sources said not less than 30, 000 people had been camped at Gorobi Primary School as internally displaced persons (IDPs) since the bloodletting started on Monday night.

Yohanna Mathias, the Chief Press Secretary to Governor Mohammed Jibrilla, who is an indigene of Gorobi, confirmed the attack during an interview.

He said scores of people who sustained various degrees of injuries had been evacuated to Mayo-Belwa Hospital.
