Man Loses Wife, Twins In Auto Crash

OWERRI – Emeka Nwosu, a man in his late 30s from Owerri West Local Government Area of Imo State, reportedly lost his wife and twin babies in a motor accident along Irette Owerri-Onitsha Road in Imo State.

Speaking with DAILY INDEPENDENT in Owerri, Nwosu alleged that his nine months' pregnant wife and twins about to be delivered in a nearby hospital were crushed by an Mbanefo Transport Company driver since April 4, 2018, without any help coming from either the driver's family or owners of the Hiace bus that killed his wife.

"I was in Owerri when they called and told me that my family got involved in a motor accident. At the scene of the accident, I was told that my wife, my four years-old-son and set of twins in her womb were knocked down by a Hiace bus at the pedestrian bus stop.

"While my wife died at the Federal Medical Centre, Owerri with the twins, my son had serious cuts on the head, hands and legs," he said.

He said the owners of the Hiace bus (Mbanefo) that crushed his wife were more interested in getting their bus released to them, leaving him alone to source funds to bury his wife and twins.

"Nobody has linked me up with the Mbanefo Transport Company, but the investigation police officer handling the case told me that the owner of the bus, Mbanefo, was mounting pressure on him to prosecute the matter and get his bus released to him.

"I am in touch with my lawyer who is working to ensure that the vehicle will not be released until issues relating to my wife's death is settled either in court or out of court," he added.

Speaking with Nwosu's lawyer, Barrister Shed Anyalewechi, he said that the driver had been released on bail a few days ago with a view to finding a solution with particular reference to how the victims would be taken care of.

The lawyer also confirmed the allegations that owners of Mbanefo Transport Company wanted their vehicle released irrespective of the feelings of the victims and their primary responsibilities to victims involved in the accident.

Such demand, the lawyer said, was resisted as the court specifically ordered that the affected vehicle should not be released until the determination of the case.
