

# Robbery Suspect Who Escaped From Police Custody Killed In Ondo

**Akure** – Bukola Adeoye, a suspected armed robber, has been killed by policemen attached to the Special Anti-Robbery Squad (SARS) of Ondo State Police Command.

Adeoye, popularly known as Agbara, was one of the suspects who escaped from the police custody with handcuffs few weeks ago.

The suspect was said to have sustained severe injuries in a gun duel with security operatives in Ore, the headquarters of Odigbo Local Government Area.

He was reportedly arrested and rushed to the General Hospital, Ore, where he died some hours after.

It was learnt that his gang had robbed one Gbenga Babatomi of Sabo Area, Ore, the previous night.

Adeyanju, who spoke on Wednesday while parading some suspects in Akure, the state capital, said detectives were on the trail of other members of the robbery gang.

The police commissioner said the detective from Special Anti-Robbery Squad, SARS, received information that the two suspects who escaped from their custody were taking cover in the house of one of their girlfriends, Loveth Ogbu, in Akure.

"On the 17th day of July, 2018 at about 0900hrs, Detectives from Special Anti-Robbery Squad, Akure, received information that the escaped armed robbery suspects from SARS office, Akure, one Bukola Adeoye Aka Agbara and one Rotimi Adeyeye were taking cover in the house of one Loveth Ogbu.

"A team of detectives swooped on the said Loveth Ogbu and arrested her. On interrogation, she confessed that the escaped armed robbery suspects were in Ore.

"Based on the confession, detectives mobilized to Ore and arrested one Felix Eteti, aged 27 years of Ebenezer Street, Sabo, Ore, who was a member of the gang.

"On 18th day of July, 2018, at about 0200hrs, the team received distress call from members of the public that robbers were operating at Sabo Area, Ore.

"Detectives trailed the robbers to Christ Foundation Primary School Ore. On sighting the detectives, the robbers opened fire on them and during exchange of fire one of the armed robbery suspects one Bukola Adeoye Aka Agbara sustained gunshot injury on his right leg.

"He was rushed to General Hospital Ore where he died few hours after being admitted.

"However, one Gbenga Babatomi, 48 years of Sabo Area Ore, who was earlier robbed by Bukola Adeoye and his gang the previous night, and thereafter went to the same hospital to treat the machete cuts inflicted on him by the robbers, quickly identified Bukola Adeoye as one of the robbers that attacked him.

"Items recovered from the suspects are, one cut to size gun, three cutlasses, one empty shell and four live cartridges," Adeyanju said.

Adeyanju said the suspects would be charged to court, vowing that other members of the gang who are still on the run would be apprehended.

Four policemen attached have been in detention since the escape of the suspects for negligence of duty.
