

Scores Killed As NAF Fighter Jet Strikes Boko Haram Location

UBONG UKPONG, ABUJA – Scores of Boko Haram terrorists were on Sunday, reportedly killed as the Nigerian Air Force fighter jet struck terrorist settlement at Tongule village, repelling the planned occupation of the village and attack on troop location.

A statement on Monday, by Air Vice Marshal (AVM) Olatokunbo Adesanya, NAF Director of Public Relations and Information (DOPRI), explained that the air strikes were conducted by the Air Task Force (ATF) of Operation LAFIYA DOLE, at the village lying South West of Dikwa in Borno State.

The successful air strikes Adesanya said, were a sequel to a credible intelligence that several Boko Haram Terrorists were massing up at the location, having occupied the entire village.

“Consequently, the mission was immediately planned and executed to prevent the BHTs from carrying out attacks against troops’ locations in the general area.

“Upon receiving the intelligence, the ATF scrambled NAF Alpha Jet aircraft and Mi-35M helicopter gunships, which subsequently attacked structures occupied by BHT elements in the location with bombs rockets and canons in quick succession.

“As a result of the air strikes, several BHTs were neutralised in the village while a few survivors, seen fleeing the location, were taken out in subsequent follow-up attacks,” the DOPRI said.

He added that there was also intensive damage to the settlement as captured by the NAF Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance (ISR) platform.
