Two Die In Fatal Motor Accident In Anambra

AWKA – A young driver, Emetor Ikenna Godspower aged 26, and his lone passenger Miss Uwakwe Jenifer have been reportedly dead in a motor accident along Owerri – Onitsha road.

The accident occurred on Monday morning along Ozubulu Boys Secondary school when Ikenna who drove in a white Toyota Venza car marked Lagos KSF 881 FD skided off the road and ran into a stationary trailer lorry with registration number XF 383 AWK on Monday at about 07:15 am

Ikenna we gathered hailed from Amaubo Ubomiri in Mbaitoli local council of Imo State and his passenger Jenifer aged 24 was a student of Federal University of Technology, Owerri.

Police Public Relations Officer, Haruna Mohammed, a Superintendent of Police in a statement made available to newsmen that "Ikenna, lost control due to over speeding and ran into a stationary trailer lorry with registration number XF 383 AWK on Monday at about 07:15 am near Ozubulu Boys Secondary school as a result both sustained serious injuries".

Mohammed, said police patrol team attached to Ozubulu Division visited the scene and rushed the victims to Oraifite general hospital where they were certified dead.

Meanwhile, police said corpses of the two accident victims have been deposited at the hospital morgue for autopsy and case is under investigation to ascertain the actual cause of the accident.

However, Commissioner of Police, Garba Baba Umar has enjoined members of the public particularly road users to refrain from reckless driving and to drive with caution especially during this period of ember months in order to avert such occurrence.
