NBA Chairman Assassinated In Enugu

ENUGU – The Enugu State Command of the Nigerian Police has confirmed the alleged assassination of Mr. Emeka Agundu, the branch chairman of Nigerian Bar Association (NBA), Obolloafor branch, Enugu State.

It was gathered that Agundu died on Sunday from gunshot injuries he sustained when unknown gunmen, suspected to be hired assassins, attacked him about a week ago.

The incident happened at Obolloafor, Udenu LGA of Enugu State, where Agundu operated his law chambers.

The gunmen reportedly shot the NBA chairman while he was inspecting a piece of land in the company of some neighbourhood watch members in the area.

His assailants were said to have also carted away some documents and valuables from his car after the attack.

Ebere Amaraizu, the police spokesman in Enugu State, confirmed this report.

Amaraizu, a Superintendent of Police (SP) said the police have launched a full scale investigation into the incident.

"I can confirm to you that the incident happened. I don't have the details for now. But as soon as I get the details, I will update you on the incident," Amaraizu said.

It was gathered that the victim was born and bred in Obolloafor, his maternal home and was married with two children.

Although Agundu was of Anambra State origin, after his law studies, he established a law chambers in Obolloafor where he practiced until his death.
