

Man Sacrifices Nine-Month-Old Daughter To His 'God' In Benue

Benue State Command of the Nigeria Police has confirmed the arrest of a man alleged to have "sacrificed" his nine months old daughter to an unnamed god in Benue state.

The incident took place in Mbangur, Tse-Agberaba, Konshisha Local Government Area (LGA) of the state on Wednesday.

Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO) Moses Yamu who confirmed the arrest of the man, simply said "The man has been arrested and investigations ongoing."

He explained that the man who has been arrest-

ed by the police in the area was yet to be brought to the command headquarters in Makurdi.

Pressed for further details, he said he would give more details as soon as the suspect was brought to Makurdi later on Thursday.

Earlier, Daily Independent gathered that the man who was identified as John Depuun had slaughtered his nine months old baby girl as a sacrifice.

According to an eye witness, the man was picked up by the police shortly after he committed the crime.

We further gathered that he allegedly snatched his daughter from his wife, took her to a bush, where he "offered her as a sacrifice."
