## Man Stabs Friend To Death In Bauchi Over Disagreement

when a middle age man named Sadique Ahmed, killed his friend over a disagreement that ensued between them

The incident happened at Zango area of Bauchi metropolis where it was gathered that Ahmed, a tailor, stabbed his friend, Babangida Umar 20, on the neck to death because the deceased took his sewing machine without his permission.

Confirming the incident, the Police Public Relations Officer, DSP Kamal Abubabakar, confirmed that the incident happened on 5th January 2019.

said three suspects including the prime suspect have been arrested in connection with the incident, gave the names of the suspects as Mamman Adamu,25, Sadique Ahmed,20, and Adamu Isa,18, said investigation into the incident had begun.

The father of the deceased, Umar Mohammed, told newsmen that he was at the market square when one of his children broke the sad incident to him.

"I was sitting with my friends at the market after the Sahur prayers on that Saturday, when the younger brother of the deceased ran to meet me

and told me that I should come home because Sara Suka (political thugs) has killed Babangida. They thought it was the Sara Suka boys from another area that attacked him,"

— "Immediately, I left and, on my way home, I met some people carrying him to the hospital but I believe at that time he had died. So, we stopped a tricycle and we rushed him to the hospital" he said

He said he had no problem with the father of the suspect but he had been living in peace with him, adding that he was not happy about the incident, but accepted it as destiny.

Mother of the deceased, Fatima, said that she left her son at home and went to his friend's house in order to apologise to him over what her son did to him because of the peaceful coexistence between them

She said: "When I got there, I met the mother of Abubaba-kar and I started apologising to her when her son came back into the house. I then apologised to him to be patient with my son and forgive him.

"As soon as I left their house to go back home, I met my neighbour's son who told me that my son, Babangida, had been stabbed. I ran back home but honestly, I wasn't seeing clearly, it was that my neighbour's son that led me to my house." She explained.
