Army Repels Boko Haram Attacks In Adamawa

The Nigerian Army has embarked upon an ongoing military operation, repelling Boko Haram attacks on Michika and Madagali Local Government Areas (LGAs) and Gwoza-Mubi Road.

Boko Haram had ransacked two towns in

Madagali and Michika local government areas of Adamawa State leaving scores dead and several houses burnt.

After a marathon security meeting presided by Governor Mohammed Umaru Jibrilla and the security apparatus in Adamawa State an order was given and the military moved into the towns of Kirchinga and

Shuwa and Michika axis to repel the dreaded insurgents.

Speaking on the development, Mr. Emmanuel Tsamdu, a member of the Adamawa State House of Assembly, said the insurgents had attacked Kirchinga and Shuwa near Michika killing and burning houses.

He said they came

with four Hilux vehicles and several motorcycles and a bus into the towns and began shooting as people scampered everywhere.

Hon Tsamdu revealed that some people were killed in Kirchinga town while undisclosed number of persons might have been killed in Shuwa town while several houses burnt.
