Hospital, Family Trade Words Over Death Of Girl, 25

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Some family members, friends and colleagues of a 25 years old Ms. Kafayat Abdul-Azeez yesterday protested at the gate of Asokoro General Hospital, accusing the management of negligence which led to her untimely death.

the hospital management and family members have been trading words over the unfortunate incidence.

The protesters showed utmost displeasure with the circumstances surrounding the death of the deceased, alleging that Abdul-Azeez died due to lack of adequate care by doctors and nurses, the Hospital management however claimed she actually died from a multiple,

The Chief Medical Director of the Hospital, Dr. Uche Afiomah, however debunked that the deceased died due to negligence from the Hospital workers, also stated that an investigative panel has been constituted to unravel all the facts about the issue.

Afiomah therefore noted that the deceased who was admitted in the hospital on 14th February, 2019 was given

the best attention that a patient deserves. She said that the investigation billed to last for two weeks would ensure that public confidence on public healthcare system was sustained.

According to her: "The hospital attended to Kafayat Abdul Azeez, who actually registered with the hospital on the 14 of February, 2019 at 13:00 hours at accident and emergency units."
