

Nollywood Mourns As Actor, Linchung Dies In Auto Crash

The Nigerian movie industry has been thrown into mourning as one of its celebrated acts, Linchung Duke Oliver died in a car crash. According to information, the actor who plays Silvanus in the popular sitcom, 'Do Good', was involved in an accident last Tuesday, on his way back from his mother's funeral.

Another 'Do Good' co-star, Uzo Osimkpa took time out to bid her colleague farewell. "I still don't understand it all. You were a genuinely good person.

No one could have played your role better and you didn't have to be Igbo to bag it, embody & deliver tastefully. You will always be My Oga Sylva, Adaku's Oga Sylva! Life dealt you hard again & again, and you fought back again & again! You too try, REST now," she wrote.
