

Woman, 60, Remanded Over Complicity In Alleged Lover's Death

A chief Magistrate Court sitting in Port Harcourt, Rivers State has ordered the remand in prison custody of a 60-year-old widow, Priscilla Ikenga over complicity on the death of her alleged lover.

Ikenga is standing trial for allegedly pushing the victim, Eziwhuo Ejuh alleged to be a drunkard to death during an altercation.

The victim was said to have fell on the ground and hit his forehead where he died.

A police document obtained from the court alleged that the deceased visited the suspect while drunk on February 23, 2019 and in the bid to resist him from gaining access into her house mistakenly pushed him.

The incident the Police said happened in one of the communities in Emohua Local Government Area of the state.

The two-count charge of murder preferred against him was not read to her; hence she did not take any plea.
