## Suspected Cultists Kill Man In Delta Community

An unidentified young man has been killed after some men shot him at his residence in Umuagu Quarters, Oshimili South Local Government of Delta State.

The incident which took place at <u>Umuagu</u> on Saturday, was the second cult clash recorded in the area within a space of two months.

A bread seller who was alleged to be a cultist recently lost his life.

Investigation revealed that the victim was killed in his house, where he was cooking for his six-year-old son before he was shot dead.

A source said the incident happened around 4

p.m. on Saturday.

He said, "When I was in the shop. Suddenly we heard gunshots and by the time we came out of the shop, we saw a dead body."

Meanwhile, Police Public Relations Officer, DSP Onovwakpoyeya Onome, confirmed the incident, attributing it to a clash by cult groups.

She, however, disclosed that no arrest had been

made as investigation on the case was still ongoing.
