## Trailer Rams Into Four Vehicles, Kills Four

A trailer on Thursday ran into four vehicles at Cele Bus Stop on Oshodi/Mile 2 Expresswayin Lagos killing three men and a lady.

Daily INDEPENDENT gathered that the driver lost control, resulting in the accident.

Police officers led by the Divisional Police Officer (DPO) of that area whose name was not disclosed, and officials of Federal Road Safety Corps as well as other security agents were said to have rescued other passengers. As at the time of going to press details on the number of those who sustained grievous injuries were scanty. Similarly, the cause of the accident was not fully known.

A police source at the scene who pleaded anonymity confirmed to Daily INDEPENDENT that, "there are casualties but I cannot give details now. We are trying to rescue the situation the driver of the trailer has been arrested."

The officer however, failed to give identities of the deceased and those injured.

We learnt that the accident caused traffic gridlock on the ever busy expressway, forcing many vehicles to resort to u-turn in order to get to their destinations early.
