Nollywood Actor Drowns In Hotel Swimming Pool In Delta

ASABA – Nollywood actors in Asaba are mourning the drowning of one of theirs following the calamity that befell one of theirs, Kagho Harley Akpor.

Akpor, who was a fast rising Nollywood writer, actor and director, was reportedly drown in a swimming pool of a popular hotel in Asaba, Delta State.

Although details of the incident were still sketchy at press time, sources said the Nollywood practitioner was at a film location shooting a movie along with other crew members when he fell into the pool.

The source said the writer might have drowned as a result of lack of swimming skills, adding that when he was rescued from the water, a lot of damage had been done.

Commissioner of Police in Delta State, Mr. Adeyinka Adeleke, who confirmed the incident in Asaba on Tuesday, could also not give details.

Adeleke, however, said the deceased was not on a movie location when he allegedly drowned, but that he simply went to the swimming pool for other reasons when it occurred.
