

Cultists Disrupt Exams In CRUTECH, One Final Year Student Killed

The ongoing first-semester examination in Cross River State University of Technology, CRUTECH was on Monday disrupted as armed men believed to be cultists stormed the institution, leaving a 500-level Electrical Engineering

student identified as James, dead.

The victim was reportedly shot three times and when he didn't die immediately, they assailants used axe to butcher him to death.

The incident happened at the old Engineering block in the main campus of the institution and the late James was among those writing

their exams on a fateful day.

According to our source, "after hearing gunshots and being alerted that a student has been shot dead at the Electrical Engineering Department, some lecturers in the Civil Engineering Department of the institution made an announcement in the Exam Halls where Civil 500L students were writing

their final paper, that all cult members either leave the hall quietly or bear the security risk themselves, as there is no security presence."

"Quite a few got up, submitted empty sheets and left, some even forcefully collected from their colleagues in order to leave in groups."
