Pregnant Woman Killed In Lagos Motor Accident

A middle aged pregnant woman met her untimely death in the early hours of yesterday when she was hit by an UBER driver at Maryland area of Lagos state.

Daily Independent gathered that the woman was on her way to work at about 7.45 am and was crossing from the Saint Agnes Catholic church axis of the road to the Mobil bus stop to board a vehicle when she was knocked down by a Toyota Corolla salon car vehicle that was coming from the Anthony lane of the road and was heading towards Ojota.

Our source said there was a break down vehicle at the scene of the incident which blocked her from seeing the oncoming vehicle.

She was reported to have crossed the road from the front of the vehicle unknown to her that a vehicle was coming.

The vehicle hit her leaving her dead instantly with an ear phone hung on her neck.

A source said the woman may have been listening to music from her cell phone and was unable to hear that there was an approaching vehicle. Sources said the driver of the vehicle stopped some kilometers away and returned to see the casualty and even passersby at the scene of the incident were at sympathy with him as the accident was not his mistake but that of the deceased.

It was gathered that her

identity card was recovered and a call was put across to her employers who brought an ambulance to the scene and took the corpse away.

As at the time of writing this report the Police image maker Lagos State, Bala Elkana, could not be reached for comments.
