Flood Kills One, Destroys 300 Farmlands In Bauchi

BAUCHI – Tragedy struck again in Bauchi State when at least one person was killed and several others were displaced, following the flood that ravaged Kari village in Darazo local government area of the state.

The Caretaker Chairman of Darazo Local Government, Garau Adamu stated this yesterday when he paid a sympathy visit to the residents of the area.
