Drivers' Union Clash Claims One In Ekiti

ADO-EKITI – One person has been confirmed dead as members of the National Union of Roads Transport Union (NURTW) engaged one another in bloody fight in Igogo-Ekiti in Moba Local Government area of Ekiti State over disagreement on daily ticketing.

The Police Public Relations Officer, Ekiti Command, DSP Caleb Ikechukwu, said: "We heard that it was a clash between two drivers and one of them was said to have hit the deceased with a substance suspected to be a charm, resulting to death.

"Due to the fact that a life was lost, it escalated but the Commissioner of Police, Asuquo Amba, quickly drafted more men to the area and normalcy has been restored".

Ikechukwu said the principal suspect has been arrested and detained by the police while investigation commences into the case.

The deceased, who was said to have been attacked by the suspect with substance believed to be charm, reportedly died on the spot.
