

Onitsha: Sugar Cane Seller Allegedly Kills Colleague In Brawl

The Police in Onitsha have arrested a sugar cane seller, Jubrin Mohammed, for allegedly killing his fellow sugar cane seller during a brawl between them.

The Police Public Relations Officer Anambra Command, Haruna Mohammed, who confirmed the incident, said that on Monday that about 10 a.m. the police at Awada Police Station got a report that Jubrin Mohammed who is 20 years and from Jigawa State and sells sugar cane allegedly stabbed and killed Hamisu Ibrahim aged 25 years to death.

Both of them are sugar cane sellers who carry out their businesses at the Upper Iweka area along Onitsha-Enugu expressway, Onitsha.

He said the police visited the scene of crime and saw the slain trader in a pool of his own blood.

His assailant was arrested and when the police took the victim to the hospital he was confirmed dead by a medical doctor on duty.

Haruna added that relatives of the deceased declined autopsy on religious grounds and had the corpse released to them for burial according to Islamic rites.

The Commissioner of Police CP John B. Abang has ordered the transfer of the case to the State Criminal Investigations Department (SCID) for discreet investigation after which the suspect would be charged to court for prosecution, he added.
