

Gombe Accident: FRSC Returns N.5m To Deceased Family

GOMBE – The officers of the Gombe State Sector Command of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) have returned a cash sum of N500,000.00 to the family of a deceased man who was crushed to death by a tanker in the heart of Gombe, the Gombe State capital.

Presenting the cash sum along with his mobile phone and other items to the son of the deceased, the Gombe State Sector Commander of the FRSC, Mr. Godwin Omiko, said his men on rescue operation immediately swift into action when they were alerted about the accident this morning.

He said the officers recovered the money and other items from the deceased who was identified as a member of the Gombe Grains Merchants Association.

He explained further that sometime around 9:00 am along Sabon Layi road, they got a report that a tanker had a brake failure, lost control and veered off his lane, crushing the deceased to death while riding his motorcycle.
