Man Who Allegedly Smashed Baby To Death Arrested





LAGOS – Operatives of the Lagos State Police Command have arrested one Isiaka Ayobami for allegedly killing a-year-old child by smashing her head on the ground.

The suspect, Ayobami of No. 2 Ayo Ijaiye Street Isheri, was arrested by the police on October 26, 2019.

DSP Bala Elkana, the Police Public Relations Officer of the state, said the suspect was nabbed following a report at the station by the father of the deceased, one Garuba Isiaka of No. 7 Ayo Ijaiye Street.

He said the deceased father had reported to the police that he received a call from his younger brother about the evil perpetrated by the suspect.

It was also gathered that on the day of the incidence, the suspect had forcefully seized the one year old child (name withheld) from the mother and hit her on the ground.

The report said the baby's head was shattered and she died on the spot.

The PPRO further added that the suspect was almost lynched by angry mobs from the area, and it took the timely intervention of the Police to rescue him.

DSP Elkana however said the suspect would soon be charged to court for murder.
