10 Killed, Scores Trapped Under Truck In Ogun Multiple Accidents

No fewer than 10 passengers were confirmed killed in a ghastly multiple motor accidents involving two commercial buses and a truck, which occurred at Ogere on Lagos-Ibadan

Expressway Wednesday.

As at the time of filing this report, men of the Traffic Compliance and Enforcement Corps (TRACE) and Federal Road and Safety Corps (FRSC) operatives were seen making frantic efforts to rescue others currently trapped under the truck.

DAILY INDEPENDENT gathered that the accidents

which occurred at Ogere on Lagos-Ibadan Expressway around 6 p.m. was caused by a truck coming from Lagos which veered off its lane and was facing upcoming traffic and rammed into two 18-Seater commercial buses coming from Kano and Ibadan side.

One of the buses was said to have caught fire immediately following the

headlong collision.

It was gathered that in the ensuing confusion some of the passengers attempted to escape through the bus windows but to no avail.

TRACE Ogere Divisional Commander, Segun Adesanya, confirmed the news break with a promise to furnish DAILY INDEPENDENT with details later.
