Family Cries Foul Over Death Of Man, 55

ASABA – Family of a 55- year-old dry cleaner that was found hanging from the ceiling of his sitting room has cried foul over the circumstances surrounding his death.

The deceased, Mr. Moses Mordi, was found hanging from his ceiling fan and his legs were firmly on the ground.

It was also gathered that he was not in good terms with his neighbours.

The deceased, Mr. Moses Mordi Omatshey, residing at Itsekiri Road, Sapele, was found hanging from the ceiling of his sitting room by neighbours who were worried of his whereabouts and reported to his relatives who later broke into his house to find his already decomposing body.

The incident was suspected to be a suicide, however, blood was found splattered on his carpet and mattress.

The sister to the deceased, Mrs. Patience Ebeneyon, amidst tears, said her brother was murdered.

"How can you say he committed suicide when it is obvious he was killed. Look at his carpet stained with blood and his mattress and other clothing's also stained with blood," she said.

The deceased, Mr. Moses Mordi was found hanging from his ceiling fan and his legs were firmly on the ground; "this suicide stuff is staged-managed," retorted his sister.

The deceased's cousin, Florence Omagbemi, also showed newsmen the back door to the house that the alleged killers must have used to enter the house adding that his pressing iron was on (is connected to power) as at the time he was found while pleading to the Police to find the killers.

When his body was taken to the mortuary, it was rejected, as such; his family had to bury him immediately.

Calls were made to the Delta State Police Public Relations Officer, Onome Onowhakpoyeya, who said the command was yet to be informed of the incident.

However, a Police source told newsmen that the police were investigating a possible case of murder that looked like suicide.
