

## Man Submits Self For Arrest After Allegedly Killing Dry Cleaner

**LAGOS** – A middle-aged man simply identified as Amos Ekuma, is being detained after submitting himself to the police for allegedly killing a dry cleaner during a fight in Lagos.

Police said the suspect was arrested for murder after he turned himself in at the station following the death of the deceased whom he claimed had gone to his shop to fight him.

A statement signed by the state's police spokesperson, DSP Bala Elkana, said, "One Amos Ekuma of No. 59, Ajipon Street, Ohio, Ogun State on December 14, 2019 submitted himself to the police in Ikorodu over the incident.

"The suspect added that he was in Ikorodu that he was in his shop on 13/12/2019 at about 1900hrs along Sabo road by Kokoro Abu Ikorodu, when one dry cleaner beside his shop popularly known as Actor attacked him with iron rod as a result of an argument that ensued between them earlier in the day that was resolved by neighbours.

"When he pushed him, the said Actor fell down and was rushed to Ikorodu General Hospital for treatment but died while on admission.

"Corpse of the deceased was deposited in the mortuary for autopsy while the suspect was placed in police custody for a discreet investigation by homicide detectives from the State Criminal Investigation Department, Yaba." the statement explained.
