

Gbagada Murder: Four Suspects Arrested Over Death Of Moradeun

The Police Lagos State Command on Wednesday said it has arrested four suspects in connection with the murdered of a lady, Moradeun Balogun in December 3, 2019.

It would be recalled that the deceased, Moradeun was murdered on her way from work at NCIE Bus Stop, Gbagada Lagos.

Moradeun's death has generated a lot of controversies as the House of Representatives ordered investigation into her death.

The House of Representatives had begun an investigation into the death of 28-year-old Moradeun, who was stabbed by armed robbers and allegedly denied treatment by a Lagos hospital.

The House also called on the Inspector General of Police, Mohammed Adamu, to

investigate the matter and prosecute those found to have been responsible for her death.

Balogun was stabbed on the neck by the robbers in the Gbagada area on December 2, 2019, while returning from work.

Police gave names of those arrested in connection with the crime as: Ugochukwu Udochukwu,, Chidiebere Nnanna, Samuel Nnanna, and David Obi.

It was further gathered that the victim was rushed to R-Jolad Hospital, where she was allegedly not attended to because a police report was not presented by the Good Samaritans who came to her rescue.

The hospital had, however, refuted the claim that the victim was not attended to because of the non-presentation of a police report, adding that she was assessed by two doctors before she was referred to the Gbagada General Hospital for vascular surgery.
