

Miyetti Allah Alleges Killing Of Members By Vigilantes In Niger

MINNA – The Miyetti Allah Cattle Breeders Association of Nigeria (MACBAN) has raised the alarm over alleged killings of its members by some vigilance group in Mashegu Local Government Area of Niger State even as the vigilantes have described the allegations as ‘all lies’.

Deputy National President of the association, Alhaji Usaini Yusuf Bosso, disclosed this yesterday while addressing newsmen over what he termed, ‘unwarranted attacks and killing’ of members in Minna, the state capital.

Yusuf Bosso, who condemned attacks on the cattle breeders, told journalists Tuesday that about 21 MACBAN members were feared dead and their corpses burnt beyond recognition by suspected vigilantes.

Also speaking, one of the victims of such killings, Malam Muhammadu Dabo, recalled how three of his sons were burnt beyond recognition in his presence at Tashar Hajiya village in Mashegu by some members of the local vigilance group.
