Cultists Invade Pastor's Home, Kill Wife, Son, In Delta

WARRI – Tragedy struck in the home of one Pastor Amos Ufuoma, who resides at Ovwian, express junction, near Warri in Delta State as Oravwe Ogangan confraternity cult group struck killing the wife and son in their cold blood.

Lizzy Ufuoma, 17- year-old daughter of the pastor, who witnessed the attack on Sunday said the cultists numbering seven were on the trail of two brothers, Ejimi Ken Isaiah and Ejimi Jesse Ejiro, and others who, they claimed had betrayed the confraternity and that the Pastor was the brain behind their escape hence their visit.

Lizzy, who spoke to newsmen after briefing the police on the incident said the cultists descended on her mother, Mrs. Dorcas Ufuoma, and her elder brother, David Ufuoma, and killed them in cold blood since they could not find their targets in their home.

She said the cultists had complained that the Ejimis had betrayed the Oravwe Ogangan confraternity to men of the Nigerian Army when they leaked information and plans of the confraternity to the security agencies which led to an attack on the group and the arrest of some of their leaders in July 2019.

Lamenting the death of his wife and son, Pastor Amos Ufuoma, said he was not at home when the cultists struck, stating that he was not aware that the Ejimis betrayed any group and that he is innocent of the accusation leveled against him by the cult group.

He lamented the psychological torture passed through by her 17- year-old daughter, Lizzy, who witnessed the gruesome murder of her mother and brother in cold blood.

As at the time of filing this report, the police said they were on the trail of the perpetrators of the heinous crime.
