## I Killed Her For Being Pregnant For Me -Suspect

A 29-year-old man, Mustapha Idris, from Ringim Local Government Area of Jigawa State has been arrested by the police for killing his 20-year-old girlfriend, Nafisa Hashimu.

The suspect has confessed to the crime saying that he killed her for being pregnant for him since they were not married.

Mr. Idris, said he killed Hashimu after she told him she was three months pregnant.

DAILY INDEPENDENT gathered that the two lived in the same apartment at Daneji village of Jigawa before the murder.

Speaking to reporters on Friday from his police cell the suspect said he killed his girlfriend to avoid the shame of giving birth outside wedlock.

"I am ashamed of how the society will see us after she delivers the unborn child out of wedlock, and thus I decided to terminate her life to stay away from shame," he said.

Audu Jinjiri, spokesperson of Jigawa Police Command, said the corpse of the deceased was found in her pool of blood in a bush at the outskirts of Daneji village about 22 kilometres from Ringim town.

Jinjiri said police preliminary investigation revealed that the deceased was a divorcee and was confirmed dead by a medical doctor before

she was released to relatives for burial.

He said the suspect would be charged to court to face the wrath of the law immediately after police investigations.
