

Man Blindfolded With Cellotape Found Dead In His Ebonyi House

The decomposing body of one Eze Burges, from Etiti Uburu, Ohauzara local government area of Ebonyi State, has been discovered in his house.

It was gathered that the middle aged man was blindfolded with celo-tape, and tied on his seat with wire while his legs were filled with

bruises. He retired from Tonimas Oil Company and returned to his home only to be killed by unknown assailants.

Source close to the family who could not give account of his family, disclosed that even pot of soup found in his kitchen was filled with maggot.

He further disclosed that the man's house and his whole compound was ransacked by the suspected assassins.

He explained that it was when the community discov-

ered that they informed Ine Eze Umezurike who hinted police in Uburu about the death of the man.

Police Public Relations officer in Ebonyi, DSP Loveth Odah, who confirmed the report said, the victim, whose body was swollen and decomposing with his pot of soup filled with maggots said the incidence happened days ago and his bags and everything in the house were ransacked.

"The man has been removed to Presbyterian Joint

Hospital Uburu for autopsy. The command will get to the root of this matter. As I talk to you now, the Commissioner of Police has ordered for full investigation into the matter and we are employing the members of the public with useful information to help the police to unravel the course of the death of this man.

"They can write a unanimous text on useful information to the police. This man is retired and returned home only to be killed," he said.
