

Again, Accident Claims Six Lives In Niger

The Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) in Niger State said four persons have been burnt to ashes in a fresh accident in Kutigi town of Lavun Local Government Area of the state.

The agency also confirmed the death of six persons in a road traffic crash that occurred on Monday on the Kutigi Mokwa road in Mokwa Local Government Area of the state.

The FRSC Sector Commander in the state, Joel Dagwa, said on Tuesday that the accident occurred at about 8.45 p.m.

According to Dagwa, the accident involved three articulated vehicles, including a tanker loaded with diesel from Lagos and bound for the North, a truck conveying a container loaded with goods and suspected to be having over 200 passengers from the North going to Lagos, and another trailer.

He said that the registration numbers of the vehicles were not visible as they were burnt.

He explained that a petrol tanker collided with two other trucks loaded with grains and scores of passengers heading to Lagos and a container truck.
