## Police Sergeant Kills Youth In Adamawa Over Alleged N100 Bribe

**YOLA** - A police sergeant has shot and killed a youth in Adamawa over refusal to give him N100 he allegedly demanded from the youth.

Dr. Idi Aminu, Chairman of Maiha Local Government of Adamawa State, has confirmed that a police officer in Maiha town killed the youth who refused to given him N100 bribe at a check point.

The youth, Mr. Arabo Dauda 20 years of age from Tambajam Ward from Wuro-ba Adamu Village in Maiha Local Government Area, was shot and he died on the spot.



According to dependable sources the incident brought serious disharmony among the entire citizens of the area as angry youths vowed reprisal attack as they mobilised against the police formation in the town.

He revealed that aggrieved youth having heard of the reckless shooting, demanded the life of the trigger-happy policeman.

They were, however, prevented by battle-ready soldiers whom the policemen ran to seeking to prevent a possible torching of the police station or the alleged culprit.
