General Enenche said, one of the operations took place in the early hours of 14 June 2020, by troops of Army Super Camp 11 Gamboru in Ngala LGA of Borno State, which effectively cleared Kusumu and Warshele Villages that appeared to be the terrorists' logistics base.

He said the troops also cleared Kumo, Diime and Sabori where they engaged some marauding Boko Haram criminals hibernating in the general area.

"After the encounter, the troops neutralized 13 Boko Haram criminals and captured 21 locally made guns, 2 Dane guns, one Sniper Rifle, one 36 Hand Grenade, one Improvised Explosive Device Bomb and 2 Boko Haram flags.

"Other captured items include 5 cutlasses, one digger, one spear, 5 bicycles, 3 motorcycles, 5 carts, 2 loud hailers and one Lister generator. The troops equally rescued 32 captives comprising 16 women and 16 children", he said.
