

AWKA -nTwenty-four days after a man died in fatal motor accident along Oba-Nnewi old Road, the Anambra State Police Command is worried that nobody has come forward to identify him.

The police public relations officer of the command, Mr. Haruna Mohammed, who issued a statement on the situation of things said that on May 29 at about 10:30 a.m., along Oba-Nnewi old Road, a Mitsubishi L300 bus with Registration Number AFZ 71 XA driven by one Sunday Igwe of No. 24 Ikwo Street, Ugwuagba Obosi in Idemili North Local Council Area of Anambra State lost control and knocked down a middle-aged man whose identity was not known.

The man became unconscious and police operatives attached to Oba Division visited the scene and rushed the victim to the hospital where he was certified dead on arrival by a medical doctor on duty.



The corpse was consequently deposited at the Gateway mortuary for postmortem examination and preservation.

The driver was arrested and obstruction cleared to enable free flow of traffic in the area.

However, since then efforts to locate the relatives of the victim have proved abortive prompting the police to bring the matter to public knowledge.

In a statement the state Police Command urged those whose relations got missing and who matched the description and photograph to report at Oba Police Station for possible identification and claim of the victims.
