AWKA – It was a wild Wednesday morning, about 9 a.m. at the sloppy hills of Agulu near Golden Tulip Hotel, Anaocha Local Government Area of Anambra State where a road traffic crash claimed the life of one person and left a few others severely injured.

The remote cause of the unfortunate incident was said to have been a lane diversion as vehicles involved were making frantic efforts to avoid the potholes on the said portion of the road where the crash occurred.

Be that as it may, the first information report on the road mishap as compiled by the Sector Public Education Officer, RC. Paschal Anigbo, further revealed that FRSC officials from Nanka outpost were on hand for rescue operations.

The accident report reads in part, “The fatal crash involved a Toyota Highlander with enlistment number FGG33KJ and Hijet Daihatsu Pickup, without registration number. A total of five male adults were also involved.”
