ASABA – Tongues are waging in Owa-Alero community, Ika North East Local Government Area of Delta State, following the gruesome murder of a teenage girl by unknown persons suspected to be ritualists.

The murdered 17-year-old, according to our sources, left her home in the night to buy food.

It was also gathered that the late teenager was discovered at a heap of sand a few metres from her house with a bottle of soft drink and a packet of chin chin close to her.

An witness who saw the lifeless body of the girl said that no part of her body was missing and there was no drop of blood in the scene.

It was alleged that the victim was stabbed at the upper part of her ribs and a pipe inserted through an opening into her body where her blood was said to have been drained.
