ABUJA – The Nigerian military on Tuesday said that its troops of Operation ACCORD on Sunday killed two armed bandits and arrested three during a fierce encounter in Kaduna State.

Major General John Enenche, Coordinator of Defence Media Operations (CDMO), who disclosed this in an operation update, said the success was recorded in conjunction with local vigilantes supported by close air support, during a search and rescue and clearance operation at Dajin Kajuru in Kajuru Local Government Area of Kaduna State.

He said, "In the course of the operation, contact was made with armed bandits. After a fierce encounter, two armed bandits were neutralised while unconfirmed number escaped with gunshot wounds.

"During the exploitation by the gallant troops, two magazines, 36 rounds of 7.62mm Special ammunition and two motorcycles were recovered.

"In the same vein, following credible intelligence on the criminal elements who escaped from the onslaught earlier, troops apprehended three of the criminal elements in Kujeni Village."
