

Family Demands N50m Compensation, Apology, Others Over Murder of Son In Edo

Family members of alleged police brutality, Mr. Ibrahim Momodu, have petitioned the chairman of the Edo State Judicial Panel of Inquiry on the EndSARS protest, Justice Ada Ehi-giamusoe (Retd), over the murder of their son by policemen in 2013 in the state.

They are demanding for an urgent invitation, investigation and prosecution of one Mrs. Carol Afegbai, a Chief Superintendent of Police and others at large over alleged murder.

The Momodu, family in a petition through their lawyer, Jefferson Uwoghiren, dated 27th of October, 2020, a copy of which was made available to newsmen yesterday, urged the panel to invite Afegbai and others now at large for alleged complicity and conspiracy to murder, obstruct justice and conducts prejudicial to public peace.

They are also asking for N50m compensation for loss of affection, emotional distress and grave injustice done to them by "agents of government, sworn to protect lives and properties.
