Military Air Strikes Kill Scores Of ISWAP Fighters In Borno

The Nigerian military on Tuesday said that its Air Task Force (ATF) of Operation Lafiya Dole, has killed scores of fighters of the Islamic State of West Africa Province (ISWAP), during its air offensives in Borno State.

Major General John Enenche, Coordinator of Defence Media Operations (CDMO), disclosed this in an operation update released in Abuja.

General Enenche said

that the Air Task Force also knocked out the ISWAP logistics base during the air strikes conducted at Tumbun Rego on the fringes of Lake Chad in the state.

He said the mission was executed on November 22, 2020, on the heels of credible intelligence reports indicating that the location, with its makeshift structures camouflaged under dense vegetation, was being used by the terrorists as a hub for logistics items conveyed via the lake and its tributaries for onward transportation using trucks and motorcycles.
