

Protesters Block Roads, Set Bus Ablaze For Killing Three In Delta Community

While the pains of the gruesome murder of about 10 youths of Oleh extraction, Isoko-South Local Government Area allegedly by their Ozoro kinsmen over a disputed parcel of land is yet heal, a bus belonging to Agofure Transport Line has purportedly killed three persons along Owhelogbo Road, Isoko-North Local Government Area of Delta State.

The youths from Owhelogbo were said to have blocked all roads linking Isoko while protesting the murder of the 10 youths, resulting into rush by drivers and other road-users to link any way in order to escape from the community.

They were also said to be angry because they alleged that a prominent politician in the area went to release the arrested suspects in connection with the murder without any proper reconciliation.

As source on Wednesday claimed the rush informed why the Agofure bus driver allegedly rammed into three persons, killing them on the spot just as passengers are now stranded in Ozoro, as there are no buses and other vehicles driving in and out while the journey of two hours has turned to six hours.
