Housewife Arrested Over Alleged Murder Of Husband In Bayelsa

Yenagoa- The Bayelsa State Police Command has arrested a housewife, Eniye Zuokemefa, for alleged complicity in the killing of her husband and lecturer at the Isaac Jasper Boro College of Education, Sagbama, Enebraye Zuokemefa.

The late Zuokemefa was reported to have been murdered by suspected gunmen on Friday, who shot at him three times after transacting business at a Point of Sale centre around Ekeki area of Yenagoa.

It was gathered that Eniye had allegedly threatened several times to kill her husband over allegations of fathering children outside their marriage following her inability to bear him a child.

The police command's spokesperson, Asinim Butswat, confirmed the arrest of the suspect, saying "she was arrested based on suspicion of previous threats."

Meanwhile, the Ijaw Youth Council has condemned the killing of the college lecturer and Ijaw youth leader, Enebraye Zuokemefa.

President of the IYC, Peter Igbifa, in a statement called on security agencies and the Bayelsa State Governor, Douye Diri, to fish out his killers.

Igbifa described the murder of Zuokemefa as "barbaric, unacceptable and irresponsible", noting that he was a firm believer in Ijaw cause and a peaceful scholar.
