

Mob Sets Two Ablaze In Ibadan, Police Warn Against Jungle Justice

IBADAN – Two persons were set ablaze by angry an mob at Asas Molete and Oke Ado areas of Ibadan, the Oyo State on Monday.

This was as another escaped being burnt through the swift intervention of the Amotekun Corps officers after been beaten black and blue by the angry mob.

This was confirmed in a statement by the Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), of the Oyo Command, Olugbenga Fadeyi.

He said investigation had commenced to unravel the situation that led to the incidents, warning that residents must desist from all act of jungle justice before it degenerates into a reign of lawlessness.

It was gathered that the person burnt at Oke Ado was not mentally sound but the mob mistook him for kidnapper as a result of incoherent behaviour.
